

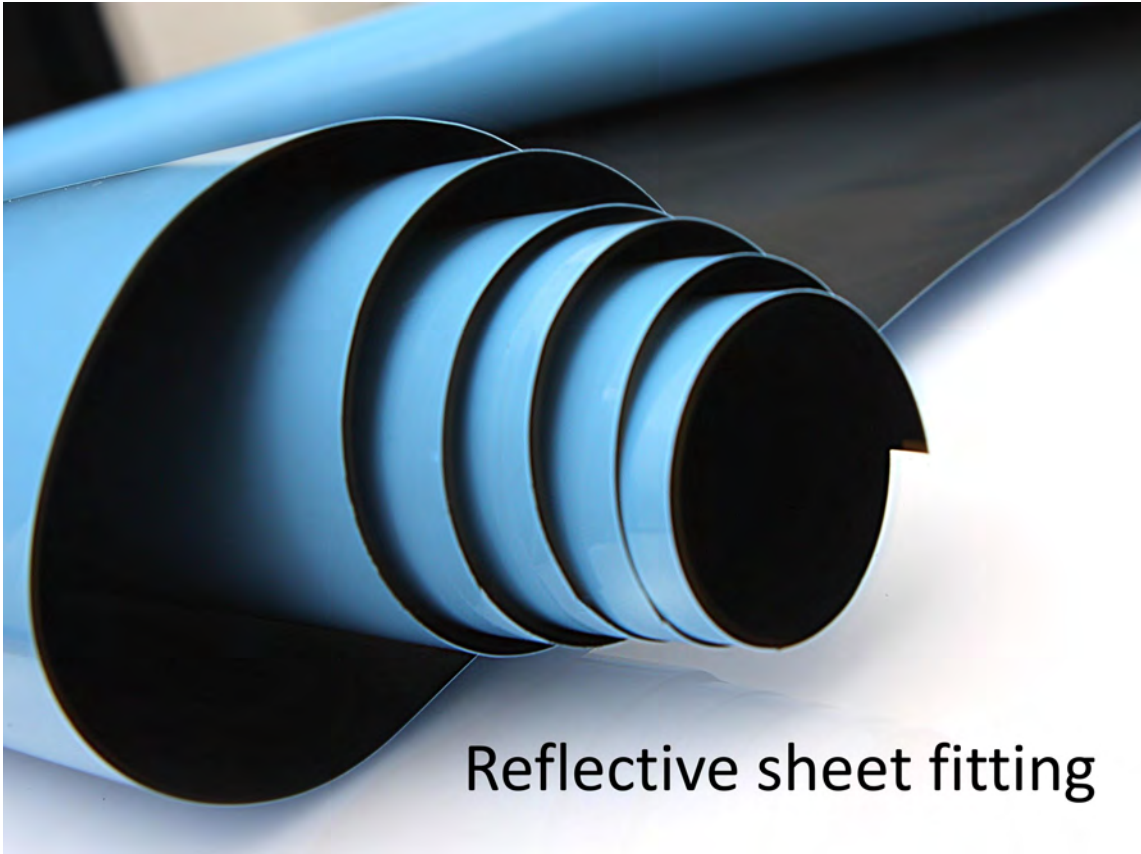

Fan Folded Method

very important

Once removed from a pool a solar cover can quickly build-up enough heat from sun light exposure that permanent damage to the cover may occur. Don't waste time in covering it with the provided protective sheet. Heat damage is not covered by your warranty.

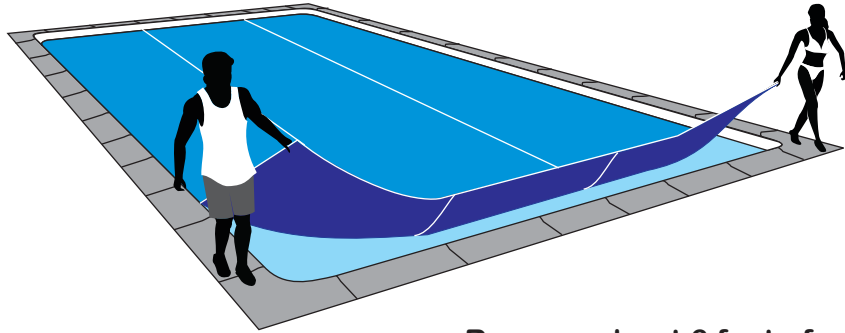

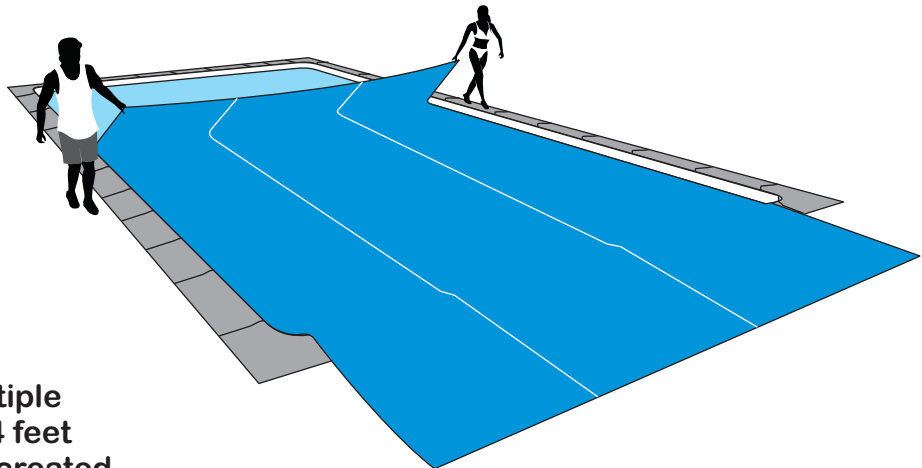
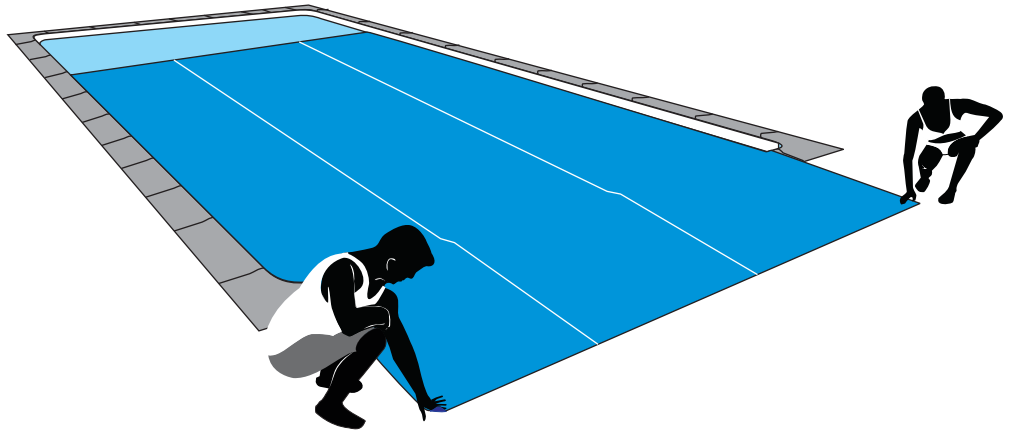
Reflective sheet fitting

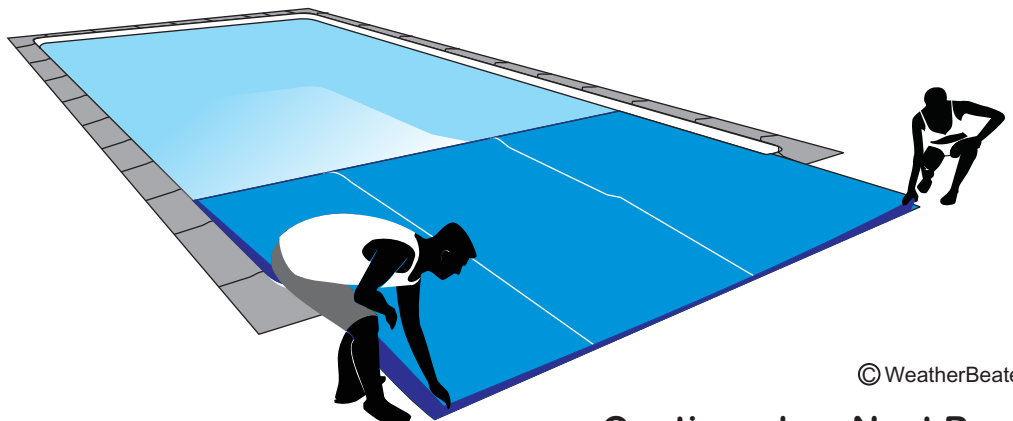
Fan Folding Solar Pool Cover And Protecting With A Reflective Sheet When A Reel Is Not Used



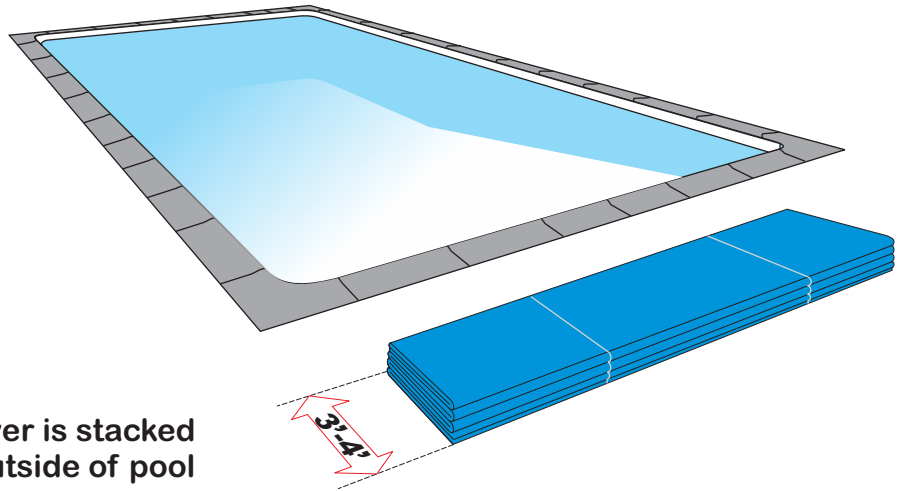
Remove about 6 feet of cover material out of pool onto deck



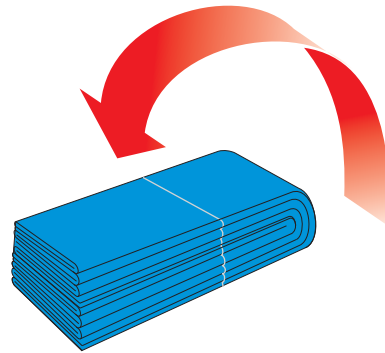
Fold cover in halves multiple times until a single 3 to 4 feet wide fan folded stack is created outside of the pool



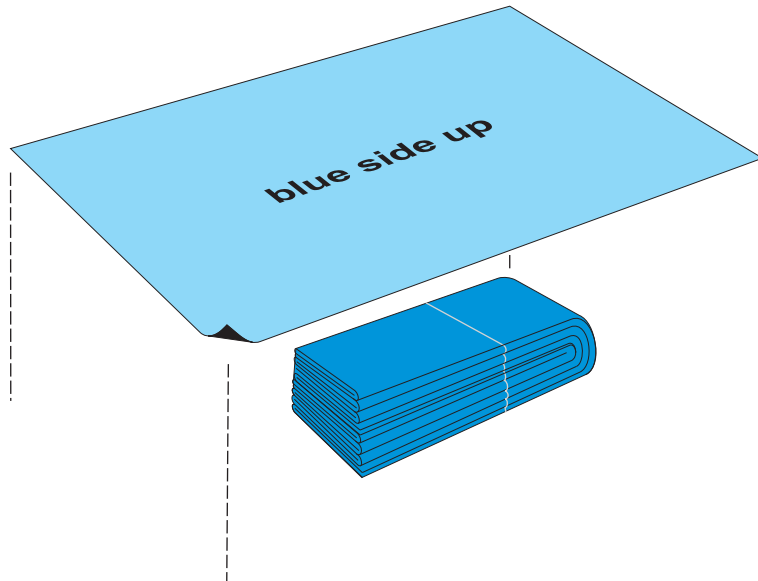
Fan Folding Continued



Fan folded cover is stacked outside of pool

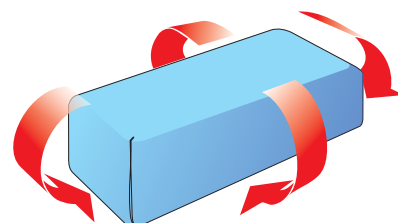
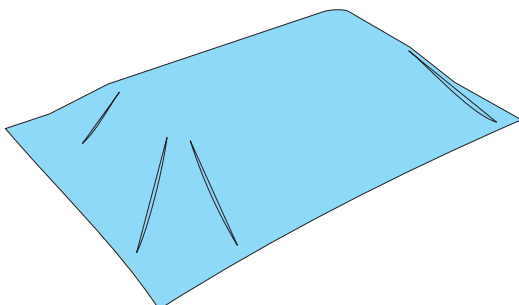


Fold solar cover in half in the opposite direction



Move solar pool cover to its storage area and place reflective sheet over it with the light blue side facing-up

Avoid storing cover on lawns or landscaping as severe plant damage can occur



tuck reflective cover around and under pool cover like a bed sheet over a mattress
